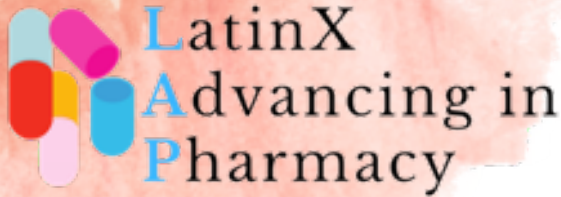


WHO ARE WE?
